However, the University may take appropriate action, including, but not limited to the impositions of sanctions under Sections 200.20 and 200.025 of the Collected Rules and Regulations against students for conduct occurring in other settings, including off campus, in order to protect the physical safety of students, faculty, staff and visitors or if there are effects to the conduct that interfere with or limit students' ability to participate in or benefit from the University's educational programs and activities
